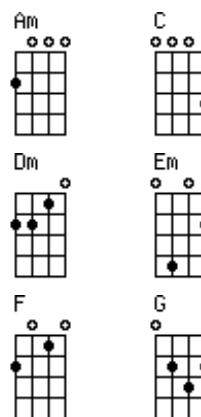


THE WATER IS WIDE
