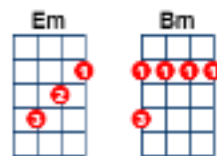
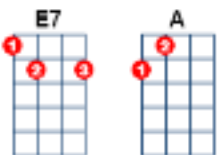
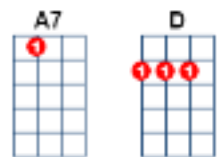


# You Raise Me Up
